**Water Main Break at 70<sup>th</sup> Street and Niagara Falls  
Boulevard in City of Niagara Falls Repair Complete; NFWB  
Now Assessing Second Water Main Break at 38<sup>th</sup> Street  
and Packard Road**

On Tuesday, December 26, 2017, the Niagara Falls Water Board (NFWB) identified a water main break on a 10-inch line in the vicinity of 70<sup>th</sup> Street and Niagara Falls Boulevard in the City of Niagara Falls. This break was subsequently repaired following on-site rehabilitation work conducted by the NFWB.

In addition, a second water main break was detected at 38<sup>th</sup> Street and Packard Road in the City of Niagara Falls. NFWB repair crews are now on-site working to assess this leak situation. Repair efforts are expected to commence this evening and continue thru Thursday, December 27, 2017. The NFWB will notify the public upon completion of the repair or as soon as additional information becomes available.

Accordingly to NFWB officials, the extreme cold conditions are likely a root factor in today's water main breaks, with workers working diligently in such conditions to implement repairs.
