Dear Residents of West Rivershore Drive:

Re: 2026 Water Main Replacement Project

We would like to inform you of an upcoming construction project scheduled to begin in your area. The Niagara Falls Water Board has contracted with Malvestuto Construction, Inc., to replace the water main on your street.

Our project also includes replacement of valves, fire hydrants, and the portion of the water service line from the water main to your curb box. We will be installing a modern and efficient automatic flushing device near the west end of your street to help maintain water quality. When the water main work is complete, Malvestuto Construction will restore impacted pavement to City of Niagara Falls specifications.

You may have noticed preliminary activity, including soil sampling, taking place already. Construction is expected to begin on or around March 30, 2026 and continue through the end of August. Work will take place between the hours of 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday, with weekend work only if necessary. When your water service line is connected to the new water main there may be a brief interruption to your water service (usually less than 45 minutes). Malvestuto Construction will try to alert you prior to making that connection.

During construction, you may experience increased noise, dust, and some traffic disruptions. We have included requirements in our contract with Malvestuto Construction that are intended to minimize these inconveniences to the extent possible.

The plans and specifications included in the Water Board's contract with Malvestuto Construction require the street's travel lanes to be cleared of obstructions and returned to service at the end of each workday. This means any excavation should be filled or plated at the end of each day. The contractor also must maintain one-way traffic during working hours and provide proper access to driveways. We have communicated with emergency services (police, fire, and AMR Ambulance) regarding the plan to maintain access to the street. Please use caution when traveling near the construction zone and follow all posted signage.
